

ART 30

COURSE OUTLINE

The Art 10/20/30 art program at George McDougall is a sequential course that builds each year toward a specific goal. The main focus of Art 10 was to learn new materials and techniques. Art 20 was concerned with the exploration of artistic style and personal expression. In Art 30 some major objectives for student learning are:

1. Further development of artistic style.
2. Growth of artistic skills.
3. Competency in one or more media.
4. Independent study of chosen ideas and materials.
5. Self evaluation.
6. Development of personal imagery.

The Art 30 program consists of:

1. A unit based on today's political, social or economic issues.
2. A unit based on symbolism.
3. A unit based on one day of the student's life.
4. A unit based on body ornamentation, (if time permits). There will be two different projects from which to choose. The first choice of a project is based on designing and creating a metal smith project. The other project is based on alternative types of body ornamentation.
5. A unit based on creating a digital portfolio of the student's artwork.

ATTENDANCE:

As in any class, attendance in Art 30 is extremely important as there are many assignments given. In the past classes there has been leniency with handing in assignments late due to absences, but this will change in Art 30. I expect all assignments to be handed in on time. If the student is absent, they must hand in the project the day they return. If not, they will lose 10% of their mark per day. There will be no extensions for absences!

FINAL PROJECT: FINAL PROJECT WILL BE DUE ON THE LAST DAY OF CLASS.

There is a final project in Art 30 worth 30% of your final mark. I will expect you to produce THREE PROJECTS in different media. Each project is worth 10% of the final grade. Only handing in one final project may result in failing the class or seriously reducing the mark.

SKETCHBOOK:

Your sketchbook will be provided in Art 30 but the student must cover loss or damage. There will be a package of assignments given to work from. These will be handed in either twice in the semester or once at the end. As a class we will decide what everyone would like to do. If only handed in once, it must be handed in on the exact due date only. The only excuse accepted is an absence on the day the sketchbook is due. It is then to be handed in the next day!

DUE DATES:

You will be expected to hand in assignments on a designated due date. Failure to do so

will result in penalties of 10% per day. Each assignment is weighted heavily so missing one or two may result in failing the art class!

EVALUATION:

The course evaluation is as follows:

- PROJECTS	=	45%	} TERM WORK
- EFFORT	=	45%	
- SKETCHBOOK	=	10%	

The final mark in Art 30 is based on 70% of your term work added to the 30% earned from the final project. The art program is project based and marks will not be imputed in the school mark program at the same time frame as other classes. There is frequently more time given between projects to let students have more time to develop and implement creative ideas.

CLASS ROOM EXPECTATIONS:

1. All projects must be kept in the proper storage area, if not they will be thrown out! **ASSIGNMENTS ARE TO BE KEPT IN THE ART 30 CUP BOARD!**
2. You must come to class with all the necessary supplies, if not I will give you a written assignment to do!
3. All projects must be marked with your name and if this is missing you will be given a zero.
4. **You are responsible for your tables and the floor around the table, if you do not keep these areas clean YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WORK IN THE CLASSROOM!**
5. Each student will be responsible sometime during the semester for cleaning the sinks and counter areas.
6. You may have a drink in this class as long as all containers have a screw top are placed in the proper receptacles when finished. Eating can be dangerous due to the materials used in the class.
7. Art books borrowed from the art room must be signed out and returned the next class.
8. All art supplies, personal supplies and library books are not the responsibility of the art department so do not leave them in the class!
9. The school late policy will be strictly adhered by!

COURSE FEE:

The course fee for Art 30 is \$40.00 this year. This fee covers all supplies needed except the metal smith unit and any drawing supplies. The supplies for the optional metal unit will cost an extra \$10.00 to \$20.00 to cover the silver and perhaps a gem stone that is needed to complete the assignment. Those students who do not pay their course fee will be unable to work on the metal smith unit.
